

Atlanta 2010 Registration Information and Form

Payment: \$100 non-refundable deposit must be made when you send in your registration. A student is not considered "registered" until their check clears the bank. Once registered it is up to you to be sure that full payment is made for the course by April 1st, 2010. If your course tuition is not fully paid by April 1st we cannot hold your place, since the course is expected to fill up quickly.

Scholarship/Work Traders- are expected to work 15 hours total, mostly before and after the class times. Work will not interfere with class time. If interested, **please send us a letter stating why you would like to be considered for work-trade.** Please keep your letter to one page. If you wish to come as a work-trader, please fill out registration form as such, and send in the deposit. Sending in this registration does NOT ensure work-trade, since it is based on need and on total number of students registered. **All potential work-traders must have their registration in by the earlybird deadline March 24th).** After the earlybird deadline work-traders will be chosen based on need, and number decided upon based on total number of registrants. You will be notified of your acceptance after that.

Fundraising: If you really desire to come to the PDC, and aren't sure you can afford the cost, think about doing your own fundraising. Have a car-wash or a bake sale. Ask relatives and friends to gift you with money toward the course instead of a birthday or holiday gift. Would your community or organization help fund your education? Sell your stuff on Craigslist, at a garage sale, or flea market. Rent a booth at a local market and sell coffee, lemonade or handi-crafts. Play music on the street corner with a tip jar. Can you trade in some vacation time at work for cash? If you are a college student, ask your counselor if there are any funds to pay for specialized education. Think Creatively!

Lodging: This Permaculture Design Course is formatted in a "one weekend a month" over seven month format, so lodging is NOT included in the price of the design course, and must be made by the students at their own discretion.

There is no camping or lodging at the course site unless student is a resident of the property.

Meals: Since students will be staying elsewhere during this course, no meals are provided. Classes will be after breakfast and before dinner, so the only meal you will have to prepare for is lunch. It is STRONGLY suggested that you bring a bag or potluck lunch-things to share, etc. It is an important part of the group dynamic that we share a meal together as a class, and bringing a bagged lunch ensures that everyone will be back in time for class to start, so PLEASE bring lunch. There is a refrigerator and a small microwave in the classroom space so you can heat something if necessary. Coffee and tea will be provided. It is strongly urged that you also bring some snacks!

Food Allergies/ Health Form: After the Early-bird deadline you will receive the Health Information sheet, and other forms. Please be sure to fill these out thoroughly and be sure to include any information on ANY allergies.

Carpooling/Shuttle Service: There will be NO parking at the actual venue, but the MARTA station is .3 of a mile away-an easy walk to The Hearth. The Hearth has also generously donated a shuttle to pick up students at the Edgewood/Candler Park MARTA station on Dekalb Ave. NE, and deliver them to The Hearth before and after class. Daily parking (less than 24 hours) is available for free at 23 MARTA stations. See www.itsmarta.com for more details. The Hearth is located at 317 Nelms Ave. just off Dekalb Ave. NE, in Atlanta.

Cancellation Policy:

All Registrations: There is a \$100 non-refundable deposit for all attendees. Refunds for any payment above the deposit will be issued for cancellations received before March 24, 2009. For cancellations between March 25 and April 15 a 50% refund will be made. No refunds will be issued for cancellations received after April 15, 2010.
